INTRODUCTION

1. SYMBOL SUBVERSION

- Mock Uniforms and Costumes Dress as cops in absurd ways: pink riot gear, clown helmets, glitter shields
- Reverse Police Language Label them "rioters," "insurgents," "agitators," and "thugs"
- Flag Parodying Flip state or police flags upside down, recolor, distort
- Graffiti on Police Statues and Signs Publicly mark the space with shame
- Distribute "Fake Cop ID" Templates for Art Undermine badge sanctity

2. MEMETIC WARFARE

- Create and Distribute Viral Anti-Cop Memes Use humor, rage, absurdity
- Frame Police as Inept, Cowardly, and Insecure Example: "Riot gear for a water bottle"
- Make the Oppressor the Punchline Every joke weakens their psychological hold
- **Build Meme Campaigns with Daily Themes** Coordinate memetic floods across social platforms



3. RUMOR ENGINEERING

- Start Civil Disobedience Hoaxes False protest times to overextend police
- Leak "Insider Tips" That Distract or Confuse Fake threats to draw resources away
- Spread Ridiculous but Viral Conspiracy Theories About Police Incompetence
- Embed Absurdities in Mainstream Discourse (e.g. "Cops afraid of corn") Disarm belief in their competence

4. PSYCHIC OVERLOAD (IN THE FIELD)

- Deploy Flashing Lights, Strobes, Lasers, Loud Music Disorient and overwhelm senses
- Use Unexpected Props: Mirrors, Balloons, Costumes Break cognitive flow
- Chant Ridiculous Rhymes to Undermine Gravitas "Oink oink, that's the sound of the beast!"
- Make Them Laugh or Lose Composure Police fear ridicule more than resistance

5. NARRATIVE SEEDING

- Embed Anti-Police Storylines in Art, Comics, Music, Theater
- Write and Share Micro-Fiction About Rebellions, Alternate Futures
- Create "Folk Heroes" and Mythologies Around Resistance
- Turn Arrested Comrades into Icons Through Story Elevate, never disappear

6. LANGUAGE WEAPONIZATION

- Hijack Official Language: "Public Safety" = "State Violence"
- Use Repetition to Reframe Concepts: "They don't protect us, they protect property."
- Invent New Terms for Old Oppression: "Surveiltech," "Copaganda," "Badge Fragility"
- Introduce "Cursed Acronyms" to Mock Bureaucracy (e.g. LAPDOG = LAPD Office of Gentrification)



ACTIONS TO COMBINE WITH PSY-WAR

- Banner drops with absurd slogans
- Flash mobs in riot gear parody
- Theater troupes mocking surveillance
- Art installations in front of police stations
- Fake government flyers announcing ridiculous reforms
- Surprise press conferences with "spoofed" spokespeople

DISTRIBUTION TACTICS

- Use burner accounts and VPNs for memetic ops
- Create and delete accounts to go viral without trace
- Upload mirrored videos across platforms
- Print QR code stickers linking to anti-cop propaganda
- Infiltrate mainstream threads with comment storms

CASE EXAMPLES

- "Billionaire Tears" Meme Campaign Targeted oligarchs and delegitimized wealth hoarding
- "ACAB Alphabet Song" TikTok Trend Spread radical politics through pop formats
- Glitter Bombs at Council Meetings Tactical fabulousness + disruption
- Portland Wall of Moms / Leafblower Dads Reframed resistance as moral duty

CONCLUSION

Psychological warfare is what they use to colonize us. Narrative warfare is how we decolonize our minds, and theirs. You don't need a gun to destabilize a regime. You just need a good story, a sharp joke, a camera, and a crowd.

Make the cops the clowns. Make the state the side villain. Make the people the legend.
